Craig,

Thank you for updating me on the Hollywood interest in what was done to you. I am pleased to learn of the documentary filmmaker's interest in your case. When it gets filmed and shown it should be very revealing and may help get action that has not been available to us so far.

As you know, Congresswoman Giffords has contacted the Department of Homeland Security to request the investigation report. To date, it has not been provided to us. I have also followed up with the Chief of Staff to the Secretary of Homeland Security, who I have known for many years. She has been unable to find the report. She is a person I trust to tell me the truth.

The report is a key document in getting justice for you but it has either disappeared or was put out of reach before the new administration took office.

Congresswoman Giffords joined with Congresswoman Maloney and several others sending a letter to the President last year which included the following statement: *"we encourage you to take action to restore the careers of employees who were wrongly terminated or marginalized by previous administrations after blowing the whistle. Specifically, we recommend the issuance of an Executive Order establishing a program to review individual cases, and where significant injustice have occurred, to make the employee whole by restoring them to government service. The country can undoubtedly benefit from the professionalism and expertise of many of the employees who were wrongly removed from federal service."*

We believe that the President can and should address this serious issue by giving direction to his Cabinet Officers through an Executive Order.

I am glad you are still fighting for justice and only wish we had been successful in obtaining a copy of the investigative report, which could really blow this thing wide open.

All the best to you and your family. Please keep me posted on the documentary.
